APPELLATION: Côte-Rôtie AOP

LOCALITY: *Lieu-dit* of “Côte-Blonde”

VINEYARD ALTITUDE: 220-247 meters (722-811 feet)

PLANTING YEAR: 2010

VINEYARD EXPOSITION: Southeast

SOIL: Gneiss

GRAPE VARIETY: 95% Syrah, 5% Viognier

VINE DENSITY: 11,000 vines/ha (4,454 vines/acre)

YIELD: 36 hl/ha (2.2 tons/acre)

HARVEST: Manual. Double sorting process (in the vineyard and on the sorting table in winery).

WINEMAKING: 100% de-stemmed. Cold maceration in thermo-regulated stainless steel tanks then fermentation. Native yeasts. Aged 20 months in French oak barrels.

ALCOHOL BY VOLUME: 14%

CELLAR POTENTIAL: 20 years
