Sauvignon Blanc

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Touraine shines with a clear, bright hue touched by golden highlights. The nose is powerful and complex, weaving together layers of passion fruit and citrus, fresh herbal notes of boxwood and blackcurrant bud, and a subtle smoky character. On the palate, it is rich and round, with impressive weight balanced by lively acidity that brings freshness. Flavors of grapefruit, candied orange, and mango linger elegantly, making this wine an excellent choice as an aperitif, with seafood or shellfish, or alongside pike perch and river trout.

Best enjoyed at 48–50°F.

ACCOLADES

“This winery is a perennial favorite, so consider this your annual reminder to stock up for casual dinners of seafood, roast chicken and anything with goat cheese. The wine echoes the minerality of the more expensive Sancerre wines to the east, but with a softer texture and more emphasis on fruit flavors of honeydew melon, green fig and star fruit. Alcohol by volume: 13 percent. Bottle weight: 465 grams (Light).”
