

Tasting Notes

Deep black cherry, red plum, and raspberry lead from entry through the midpalate. Blackcap raspberry and currants follow, layered with a fine, lingering note of toasty oak on the long finish.

The Makeup

- 20% Chehalem Mountain Vineyard (Chehalem Mountain AVA) Calera & Mount Eden clones
- 10% Cherry Grove Vineyard (Tualatin Hills AVA) Pommard
- 70% Hirschy Vineyard (Yamhill-Carlton AVA) Dijon 667, 777, & Wadenswil clone

The Methodology

Crafted with organic principles from vineyard to bottle. Handsorted fruit was 100% destemmed and fermented in small, open-top 1.5-ton fermenters. The wine aged for 16 months in a mix of new and seasoned French oak, with lees stirred during the first 9 months of élevage. Minimal effective SO₂ was used throughout.



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
