## Boedecker Cellars

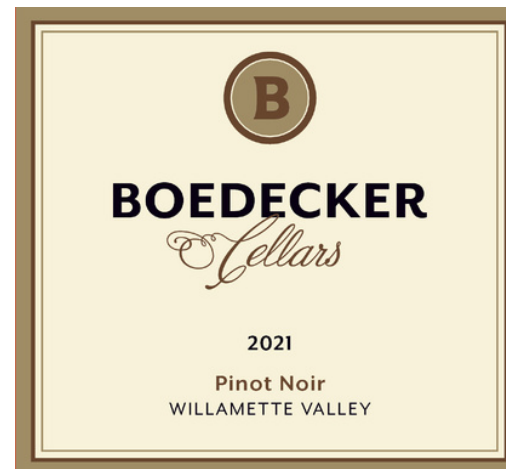

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The aroma is filled with raspberry and mulberry notes, along with hints of spice and cola. It showcases remarkable depth, offering a blend of red and blue fruit flavors.

The tannins are silky and well-integrated, providing a velvety texture that lingers on the palate, making each sip a layered experience. The finish is long and elegant, leaving a lasting impression of finesse and balance.

### The makeup

A valley blend of 100% Pinot Noir from all of our vineyard partners: Cherry Grove, Hirschy and Shea vineyards, 20% whole cluster, indigenous primary yeast, naturally occurring malolactic bacteria, minimal effective So2.

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### The methodology

Organically driven from vineyard to bottle. Sorted by hand in the vineyard and winery, fermented in small open top 1.5ton fermenters, aged 12 months in neutral barrels, sur lie élevage.

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
