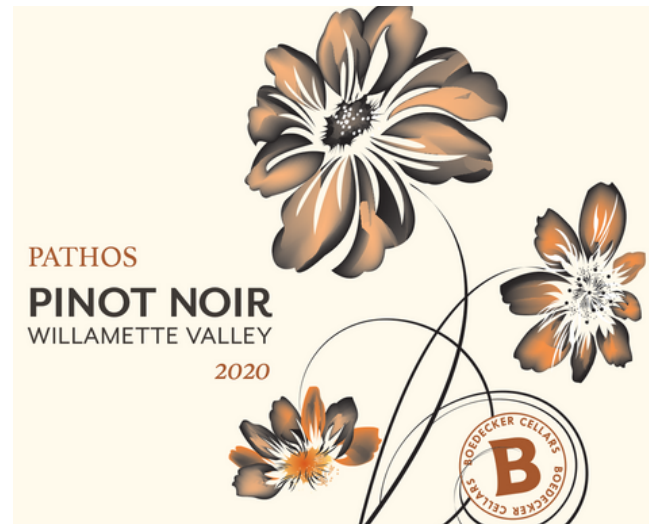
Boedecker Cellars

Tasting Notes

Light bodied with soft tannings and intense, flavors. Bright red fruited aromatics burst from the glass and on the palate the flavors include strawberry, tart cherry, Oolong tea, cracked black pepper and blackberry jam. This intriguing wine is a complex mashup of red fruit with black undertones; wine we consider quite a passionate (Pathos) Pinot Noir.

The makeup

A valley blend of 100% Pinot Noir from our grower partners: Cherry Grove, Shea, and Hirschy Vineyards.

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The methodology

Organically driven from vineyard to bottle. Sorted by hand in the vineyard and winery, 100% destemmed, fermented in small open top 1.5ton fermenters, aged 19 months in a mix of new and seasoned French oak barrels, clean élevage.

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
