Harvest Dates: September 17 – 20, 2021.


Production: 500 cases

The Vineyards

57% Pommard from Cherry Grove Vineyard in the Tualatin Hills AVA, 28% clonal blend from Hirschy Vineyard, in the Yamhill-Carlton AVA and 15% 115 from Shea Vineyard in the Yamhill-Carlton AVA.

Methodology

20% whole cluster, hand picked, hand sorted in the winery, spontaneous ferments from native yeast in small 1.5 ton open top fermenters, naturally occurring malolactic bacteria, 18 month élevage, lees stirred, minimal effective so₂, egg whites for fining.



Notes

The Stewart is our nod to classic, refined and elegant Willamette Valley Pinot Noir. Aromatic and fruit-driven with oodles of juicy strawberries, raspberries and cherries and a touch of dark earth and forest brambles. Medium-bodied with a mellow, mid-palate with sliced strawberry character and a long, lively finish.
