


# 2021 Hirschy Vineyard Pinot Noir, Yamhill - Carlton

## The Tasting Notes

“Spicy and textured, featuring dried cherries, black tea, star anise and a touch of forest floor. Medium-bodied with compact yet velvety tannins and a lightly chewy, savory finish. Earthy complexity adds depth.” 92 James Suckling

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## The Vineyard

Hirschy Vineyard, Yamhill - Carlton, Willamette Valley.

Marine sedimentary soils, 300'-450' Elevation.

Planted in 2007 and sustainably farmed, with a focus on soil health and authentic site expression.

## The Methodology

Pinot Noir clone 667, Block J. Harvested by hand and hand-sorted in both the vineyard and winery.

Spontaneous native yeast ferments in small, 1.5-ton open-top fermenters. Malolactic conversion occurred naturally in barrel.

Aged for 18 months in French oak beginning with 10 months of sur lie élevage in 2021 Rousseau and 2018 Vicard barrels, then racked to neutral barrels for an additional 8 months.

Minimal effective SO<sub>2</sub> was used to preserve purity, aromatics, and site expression.
