

ABOUT THE WINERY

The Carillon family Domaine dates back to the 16th century. Today, François Carillon farms almost 20 acres of vineyards, located principally in Puligny-Montrachet.

THE WINE

The vines are located to the north of the village (Puligny side), with a terroir quite similar to that of Perrières (limestone and rocky land). The wine is rich with a salty character. The finish is fine, nervous and tense.
