On the palate the wine is full-bodied, focused and complex, with a lovely core of fruit, good soil undertow, firm, chewy tannins and a long, well-balanced and gently oaky finish. There are some oak tannins to absorb here on the backend, but the wine has excellent depth of fruit and seems likely to eventually carry its new wood seamlessly and I would anticipate it will be a lovely drink once those tannins have started to soften up.
