

Château Mondésir-Gazin Chenu

Area: Bordeaux

Appellation: Blaye Côtes de Bordeaux

Cuvée: Chenu Color: White

Soil: Clay-limestone Planting density: 6.100 plants/ha

Yeld: 40 hl/ha

Grapes: Sémillon (55 %) – Sauvignon (45 %)

The Sauvignon grape variety is recognizable by its aromas of citrus, peach, pear, boxwood, and blackcurrant blossom.

The Sémillon grape variety is distinguished by its aromas of green apple, apricot, honey and acacia blossom.

Breeding: 6 months in oak barrels of 400 l.

Tasting comments:

The color is a clear straw yellow, shot through with gray highlights. The intense aroma is focused on white flowers and minerality. Full, round and with strong acidity, the palate unfolds a long, savory, opulent finish with notes of candied apricots.
