The Malbec grape variety produces wines of an intense color with aromas of black fruits and plum, as well as spices such as pepper and chocolate.

Breeding: 18 months in oak barrels.

Tasting comments:

The color is black! The nose is intense and very complex: small red and black fruits, violet, licorice, undergrowth, cedar, smoky notes... On the palate, the substance is powerful and concentrated, tense by a beautiful acidity, long and persistent. Carafed for two hours, it will offer the pleasure of an original and sweet discovery.
