



Château Mondésir-Gazin Chante-Alouette

Area : Bordeaux
Appellation : Côtes-de-Bourg
Cuvée : Chante-Alouette
Color : Red
Soil : Clay-limestone
Planting density : 5.500 plants/ha
Yield : 40 hl/ha

Grapes : Merlot (80 %) – Malbec (20 %)

The Merlot grape variety develops aromas of red fruits such as strawberry and raspberry.

The Malbec grape variety has an intense color with aromas of black fruits and plum, spices such as pepper, and chocolate.

Breeding : 9 months in concrete tank – No sulfites added.

Tasting comments :

The light cherry color arouses desire with its purple highlights. The still young nose oscillates between red fruits and morello cherry.

With present but delicate tannins and a long tangy finish, the aromas are oriented towards undergrowth and game.
