Since the 1990 vintage, the Pauillac has been produced each year from plots owned by Château Latour outside the Enclos, as well as from young vines on the estate. This distinguished Pauillac is a fine introduction to the family of wines at Château Latour.

The vines selected for the Pauillac receive the same attention from our wine-makers as the rest of the estate's plots. In the cellar, our team's expertise gives a wine that is both intense and silky-smooth, with a vinification process that respects the elegant tannic structure characteristic of Château Latour and reveals pure fruit and a beautiful velvety texture. Merlot takes on a larger role in the blend and a greater proportion of press wine is reintroduced, always with a view to sublimating the fruit without losing any of the depth and delicacy of the texture. The Pauillac of Château Latour may seem more approachable than the other two wines produced at the Château, but it will benefit just as much from extended cellaring.

The Pauillac label proudly displays the Dovecote, built in the 17^{th} century which is still present on the Estate.



A magnificent wine that reveals beautiful red fruit and blackcurrant on the nose, with cedar wood and sweet spices. The palate is both graceful and firm, with rich tannins and excellent depth. Juicy fruit and a refreshing finish.
