



## Clos Figueras Sweet Priorat 2022

Clos Figueras has a spectacular vineyard, with the classic "llicorella" soil, in one piece, just to the north of the famed town of Gratallops, overlooking the Montsant river valley.

The property was purchased in October 1997 by Charlotte and Christopher Cannan on the recommendation of Réné Barbier, owner of the famous Clos Mogador estate and founder of the "new wave" movement in Priorat during the late 1980's. The initial purchase of 10 hectares of abandoned terraces was followed by a new acquisition in 2000, completing the 18 hectares estate.

Appellation: PrioratGrapes: Red Grenache

• Harvest: The harvest is manual using 20kg boxes

• Winemaking: In the winery a second grapes selection is made. Fermentation is cool and expressly stoped before the end of the fermentation to get sugar.

• Bottle type: Rhine

• Vineyard Size: 18 hectares

• Soils: llicorella

## **Tasting notes:**

Red wine, purple color, clean, and with good training teardrop. Floral aromas, such as rose or violet and currant notes and almonds. On the palate it is fresh, elegant and velvety. It has a soft, long-haul, with bursts of red fruit and a nice wide end.
