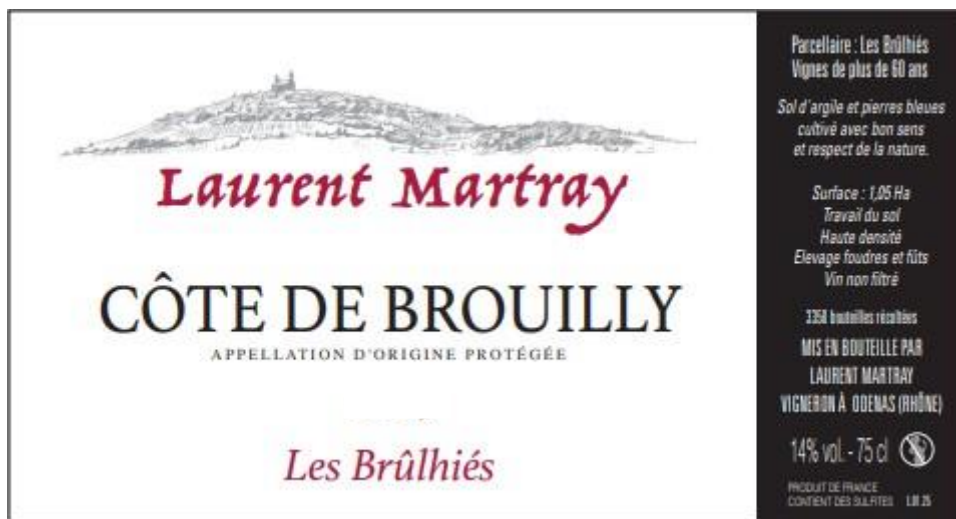


Côte de Brouilly « Les Brulhiés » 2023



Old Côte de Brouilly vines, partially planted in 1916 on the Mont Brouilly hillside, located in the village of Odenas, on the Les Bruhliers plot, near Château Thivin.

This is a limited selection with clay and bluestone soils, cultivated with common sense and respect for nature. Southern exposure.

Area: 1.05 hectares.

Grape variety: 100% Gamay. The grapes are hand-harvested.

Tillage is performed.

High-density planting.

Vinification: 14 to 16 days, 100% whole bunches with semi-carbonic maceration. Aged in foudres. Unfiltered cuvée.

Vinification in the Burgundian spirit.

Pairing: Red meats, light venison, and cheeses. Total production: 3,350 bottles.

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
