TASTING NOTES: This wine, though impressive in its youth, really begins to shine after being in bottle for 7-8 years. Exotic fruit, candied quince and truffle aromatics burst from the glass. This wine is viscous to the point of being creamy with lively acidity that knows no bounds and provides a backbone for the wine that will carry it along gracefully for 40-50 years. The length and freshness are astounding with elegance that one would never expect from a wine with this level of ripeness.
