



DOMAINE PONSOT

BOURGOGNE ROUGE, “CUVEE DU PINSON”

Since 2017, this wine has often been one of Domaine Ponsot's smallest cuvées in volume. There is a reason for this: it is produced with young vines from our Morey Saint Denis or Gevrey-Chambertin appellations that reclassify into the lower Bourgogne appellation.

Surface Area:	Decommissioning of young vines from communal or Grand Cru appellations. 0.5 ha in 2020.
Soil:	70%: clay-limestone with cone pebbles on a base of fine Comblanchien limestone. 30%: Bresse marl.
Average Production:	1200 bottles
Viticulture:	Sustainable agriculture, Cordon pruning
Harvest:	Grapes destemmed and fermented in temperature-controlled wooden vats. Native yeasts.
Vinification:	Pneumatically pressed, settled for 24-48 hours. Lengthy ambient yeast fermentation and aging for 12 months in barrels (10-20% new). Fined.
Maturation:	14 to 18 months in French oak barrels. No new barrels. Average age of barrels: 20 years
Size:	750ml
