



Located at an altitude of 350 meters in the Larzac plateau foothills, the 20-hectare estate is divided into some 40 plots and terraces on either side of the Pégaïrolles de l'Escalette and Lauroux valleys. Old vines trained in the goblet style, over 50 years old, grow alongside new plantings of mass-selected varieties on the limestone scree of the Causse. Naturally irrigated vines, altitude, deep, well-drained clay-limestone soils, and the cool climate of these valleys. These conditions come together to allow us to produce wines with a freshness and fruity intensity specific to this terroir.
