

# François Mikulski



## Bourgogne Côte d'Or

### Vine

The Burgundy Chardonnay vineyards we have cultivated since 1992 belong to Marie Pierre and François Mikulski. They cover a total area of 1.5 hectares. The first was planted in 1986 and the second in 2005 by François Mikulski. Their vines are 100% Chardonnay. Annual production: around 9,000 bottles. The vines are cultivated using non-certified organic methods.

### The soil

The subsoil consists of fine alluvial river sediment, which is common on the lower part of the slope.

### Ageing

The vintage is aged in oak barrels for about 10 months, then drawn off and put in tanks for 2 months before bottling.

### Tasting

The two parcels that we operate are on the borders of the Meursault appellation, therefore the wine's characteristics are similar to those of a Meursault: length in the mouth, rich, keeps well.
