VARIETAL: Chardonnay

**COUNTRY:** France

**APPELLATION:** Burgundy, Bienvenues Batard Grand Cru

AVERAGE AGE OF VINES: 50 years old

FARMING METHODS: Biodynamic

**Soil:** Shallow clay-limestone soil

**AGING:** Aged for 18 months in French oak barrels on fine lees

**TASTING NOTES:** The Bienvenues-Bâtard-Montrachet Grand Cru entirely transcends any of the vintage's perceived limitations, wafting from the glass with aromas of pear, citrus oil, white flowers, toasted nuts, gunpowder smoke and nutmeg. Full-bodied, satiny and multidimensional, it's layered and concentrated, with terrific depth and cut, concluding with a long, expansive finish.

"The 2020 Bienvenues-Bâtard-Montrachet Grand Cru is a resounding success, mingling aromas of peach, pear, orange oil and confit lemon with notions of hazelnuts, white flowers and buttered toast. Full-bodied, broad and muscular, it's deep and multidimensional, its satiny attack segueing into a layered, seamless mid-palate framed by racy acids and chalky structuring dry extract. Sadly, it's produced in tiny quantities, so it won't be easy to find." - 97 pts, Wine Advocate

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
