HISTORY

Further to his great success at Le Pin, Jacques Thienpont has Purchased during the winter of 2009-2010, a new estate at Saint Emilion, called Chateau Haut-Plantey and the wines were sold under this name. Today, the vineyard is reborn with the name L' IF – which means Yew Tree in French to match Le Pin and is a play on words with the English word « IF » for all the choices and possibilities faced in making wine. Château Haut Plantey is now the second wine of Château L'If. He targets the production of an exceptional Saint Emilion Grand Cru within 4 to 5 years, time to extract the full potential of this parcel, mostly located in St-Emilion, close to highly-rated land owned by Troplong-Mondot and Valandraud, on the chalky table land.
