Operating temperature: The ideal serving temperature for Château La Commanderie wines is between 15 and 17°C.

Serving: Château La Commanderie recommends traditional Bordeaux glasses, which are more tapered and have a sufficiently wide opening to ensure good oxygenation.

Tasting notes: "This starts well, with firm, summery red fruits, although they're a touch underripe. It has a nice perky form, for drinking in the medium term."
