



Château Linot is a small estate in AOC Saint-Estèphe. Its surface area is 0.6 hectares and produces 4600 bottles per year. Its plots are located on the hill of Cos, benefiting from remarkable sunshine and drainage. The resulting wines are suitable for aging thanks to a high percentage of Cabernets (70%) and 30% Merlots. They remain very accessible when young given the vinification .

COUNTRY: France

REGION: Bordeaux, St-Estephe

TERROIR/GEOLOGY: The plots of Château Linot adjoin the greatest vintages of Saint-Estèphe. The estate, made up of a high proportion of old vines, reigns over gravel soil and a subsoil made up of clay.

VARIETAL: Cabernet, Merlot

VINIFICATION: Te bunches are placed in crates which preserve the integrity of the grape. The harvest is then sorted and destemmed by hand on the wooden casings. Then comes the sorting of the berries to keep only the best. The selected berries are then directed into a stainless steel tank using a conquet allowing to do not damage them.

TASTING NOTES: A wine that charms with its delicate bouquet of red fruits, spices and cocoa with a fine and melted structure, a beautiful fullness with persistence.

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
