

BEAUNE CLOS DU ROI

PREMIER CRU 2023

This clos, located below the Les Marconnets parcel, was once owned by the Dukes of Burgundy. When Louis XI annexed Burgundy to the French crown in 1482, this vineyard was renamed Clos du Roi. **Its clay-limestone subsoil produces wines of lovely roundness and great elegance.**

Surface area in production: *0.83 ha* /13.24 ha
