

BEAUNE LES AVAUX

PREMIER CRU 2023

The name Avaux originates from the place-name 'Vaux,' referring to a hollow in the slope where the vineyards are located. Bouchard Père & Fils, which has had a strong presence in the Beaune terroir for more than two centuries (having acquired its first vines on this parcel in 1791), owns one third of this particularly steep vineyard site with clay-limestone soils.

Surface area in production: *4.36 ha* /13.79 ha
