PREMIER CRU 2023

It is the third largest climat in the entire Côte and certainly the most renowned of the commune's Premier Crus. It also holds the highest overall ranking within the Beaune appellation. This appellation takes its name from the structure of its soil, which is very sandy and promotes finesse. **This remarkable terroir produces a wine that is harmonious, intense, and silky.**

Surface area in production: *3.16 ha* /31.83 ha
