

# MEURSAULT LES GOUTTES D'OR

## PREMIER CRU 2023

The 3rd President of the United States, Thomas Jefferson, a great wine enthusiast, had a particular fondness for this appellation. Classified as a “Tête de cuvée” in 1855 by Dr. Laval, the Gouttes d’Or climat features limestone and marl soils, combined with an altitude of around 250 meters and a gentle slope. This terroir offers ideal conditions for Chardonnay and the production of **a wine that is both rich and complex.**
