

MONTHÉLIE LES DURESSES

PREMIER CRU 2023

The “Les DuresSES” climat extends across both the village of Auxey-DuresSES, where it is considered a flagship site, and the village of Monthélie, where it ranks among the most notable Premier Crus. The estate’s 1.72 hectares, often harvested slightly later than other Monthélie plots, produce wines that are rich and pleasantly structured.

Surface area in production: **1.73 ha** / 6.72 ha
