VILLAGE 2023

In the commune of Monthélie (pronounced “Monthlie”), the earliest traces of vineyards date back to the 9th century. The estate owns four plots with complementary exposures (east, south, and west): **Aux Fournereaux**, **Les Duresses**, **Le Meix de Mypont**, and **Les Crays**. This cuvée is the result of their blend.

Surface area in production: *4.68 ha* / 34.81 ha
