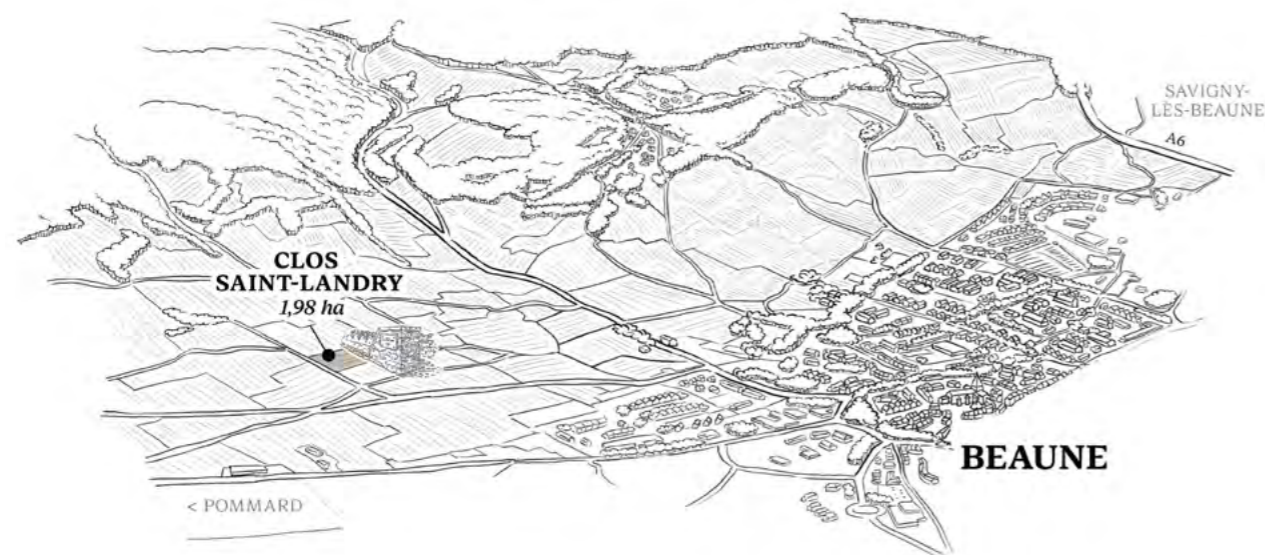


Beaune Clos Saint-Landry 'Monopole' Premier Cru

Another monopole, this 1.98-hectare climat is notable for bearing the oldest recorded traces of the Chardonnay grape in Beaune.

- Surface: 1.98 hectares
- Altitude: 240 meters
- Soils: calcareous clay and marl
- Exposure: South-East
