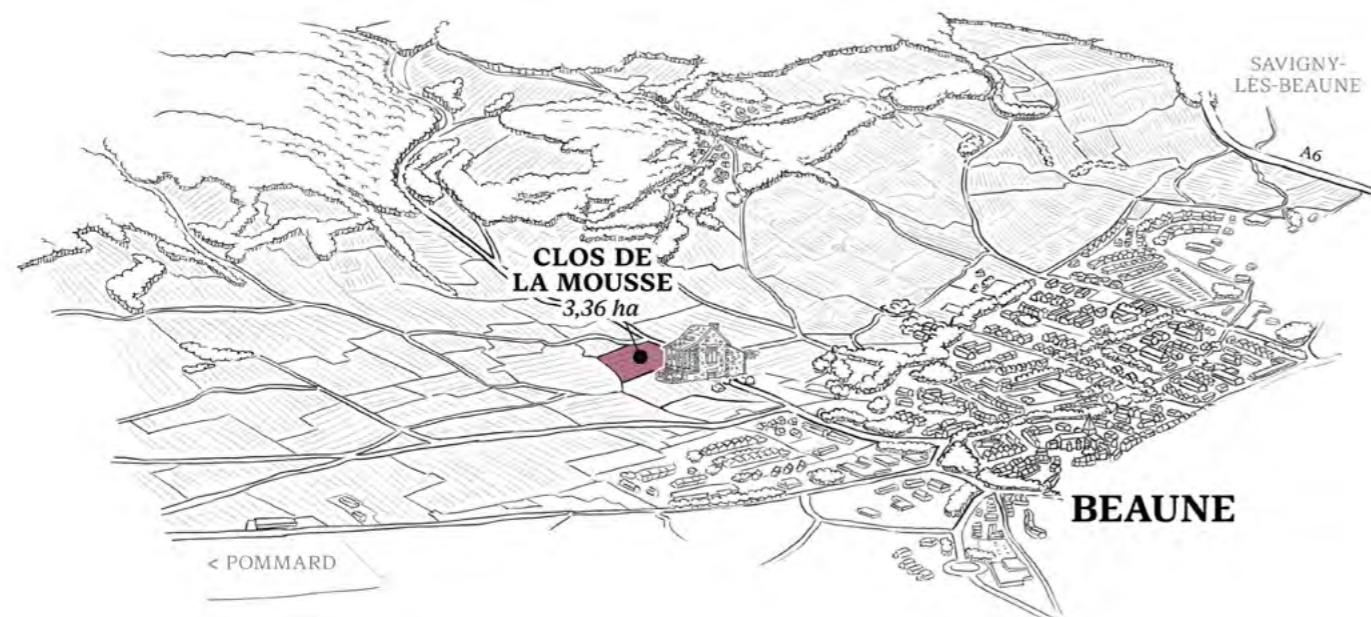


# Beaune Clos de la Mousse 'Monopole' Premier Cru

This 3.36-hectare plot, a monopole of the estate, was already mentioned in 1220. The wine it produces is consistently open, floral, lively, and tender.

- Acquisition date: 1826
- Surface: 3.36 hectares
- Altitude: 235 meters
- Soils: calcareous clay, clayey subsoil
- Exposure: South-East



## 2023 Vintage



*“An elegant, floral, and expressive nose, revealing aromas of fresh red berries, strawberry jam, iris, and peony. The palate is dense, full, and vertical on the attack. The finish is long, delicate, and smooth, with notes of gentle spices. A refined wine.”*

- Harvests: September 5 & 7, 2023
- Whole cluster: 30%
- New oak: 35%
- Ageing: 20 months
