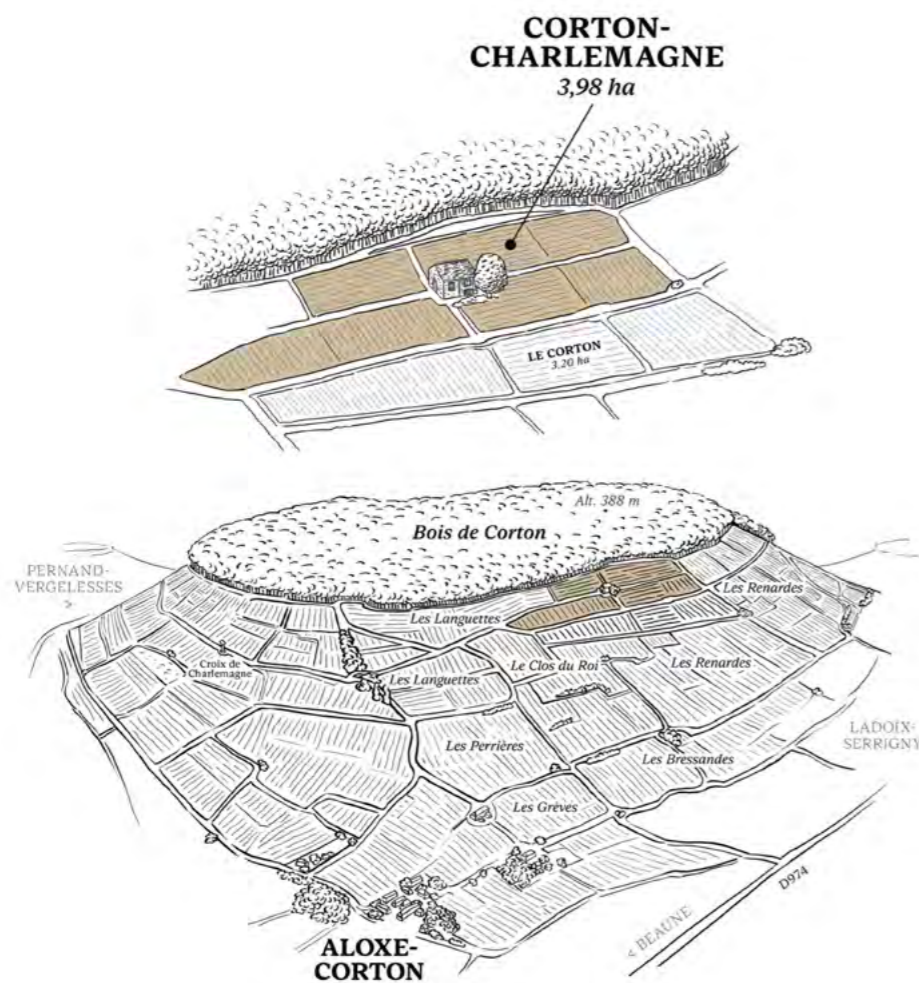


Corton-Charlemagne Grand Cru

2023 Vintage

Located at altitude, facing east, in the climat 'Le Corton', which has a rare characteristic: it can be planted with either pinot noir or chardonnay.

- Acquisition date: 1909
- Surface: 3.98 hectares
- Altitude: 340 meters
- Soils: shallow marly on a limestone bedrock
- Exposure: East / South-East
