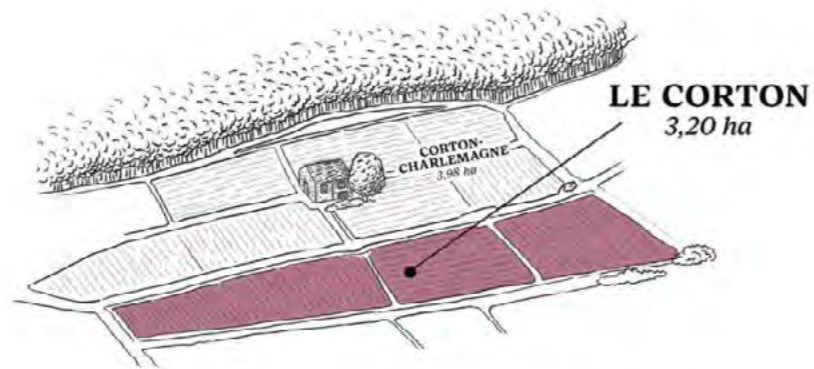


Corton Le Corton Grand Cru

The only red Grand Cru of the Côte de Beaune, Corton is also the sole Côte d'Or Grand Cru divided into sub-climats. Our Corton 'Le Corton' faces east and produces a wine of remarkable finesse.

- Surface: 3.20 hectares
- Altitude: 320 meters
- Soils: calcareous clay with traces of iron
- Exposure: East
