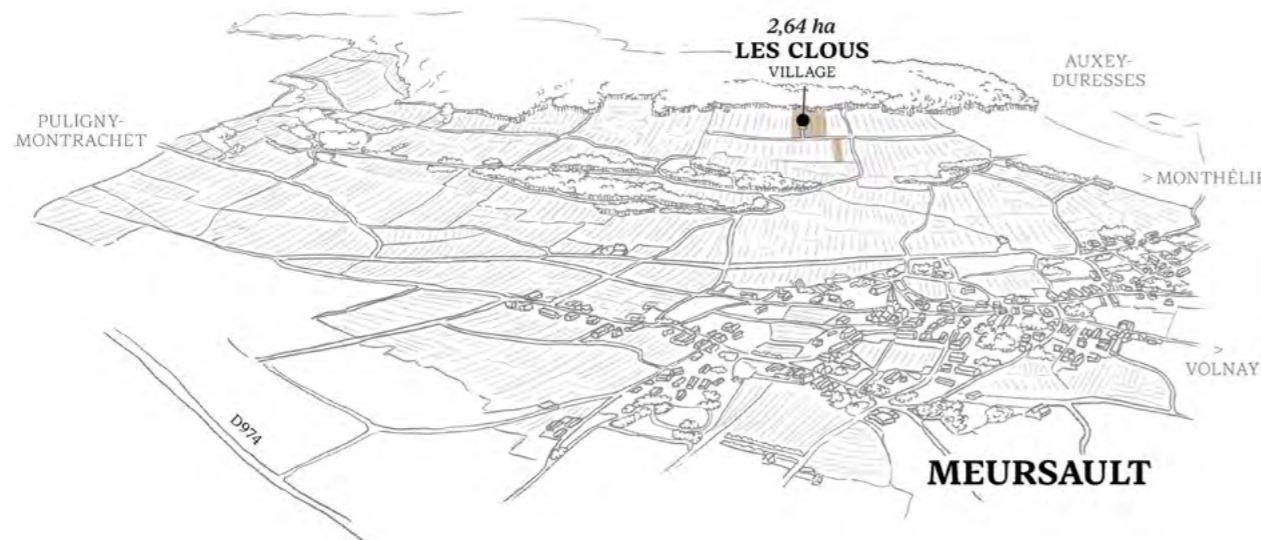


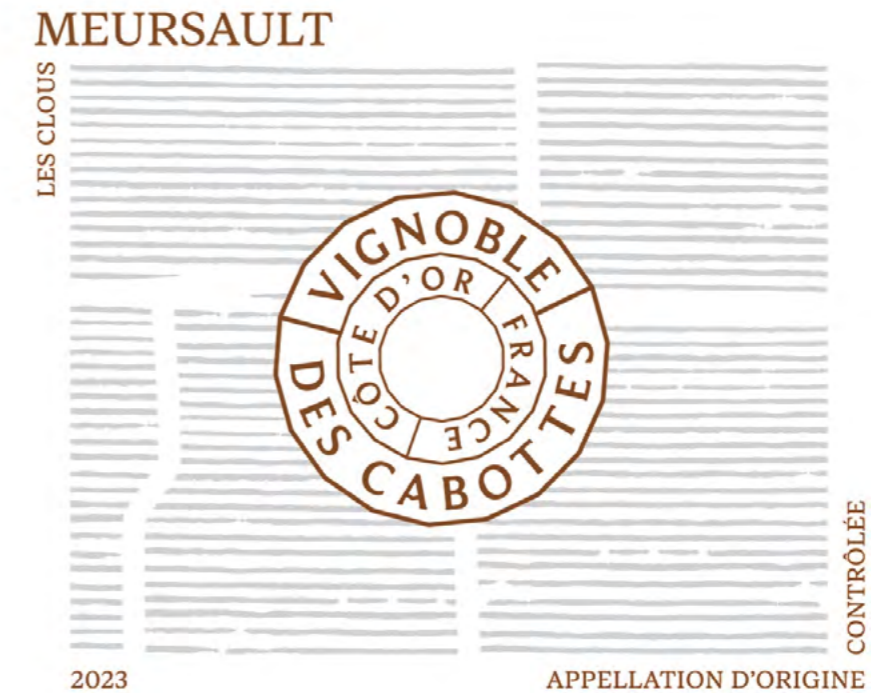
Meursault *Les Clous* Village

Exposed to the east, high on the Meursault slopes, this terroir—built on a compact, exposed marl-limestone bedrock—yields a wine that is always energetic and finely sculpted.

- Soils: calcareous marl on compact bedrock
- Exposure: East
