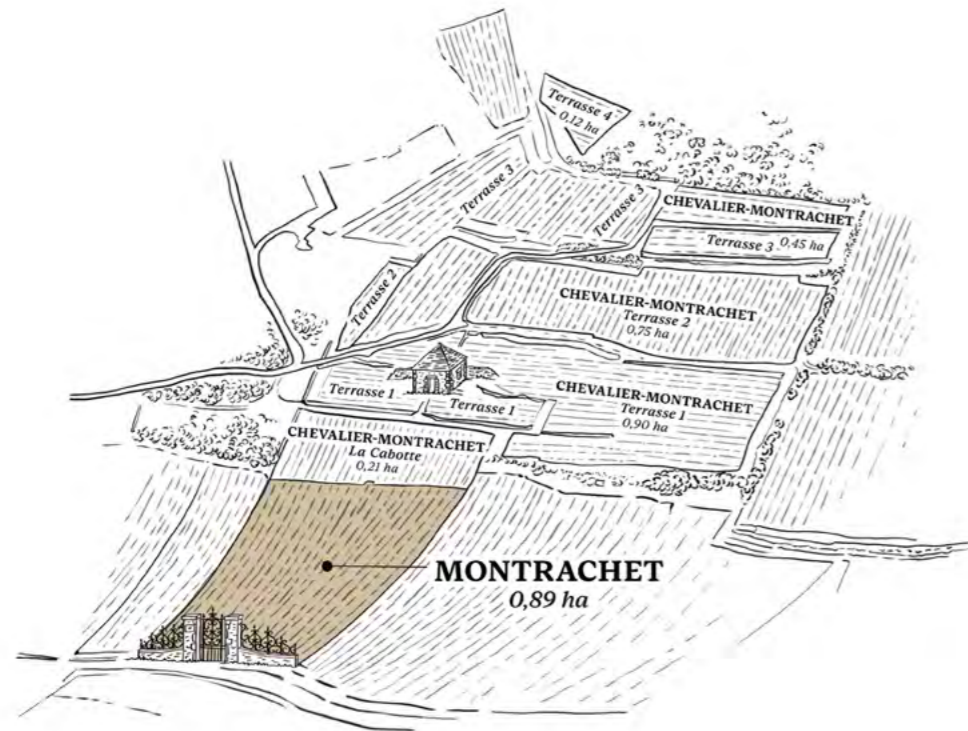


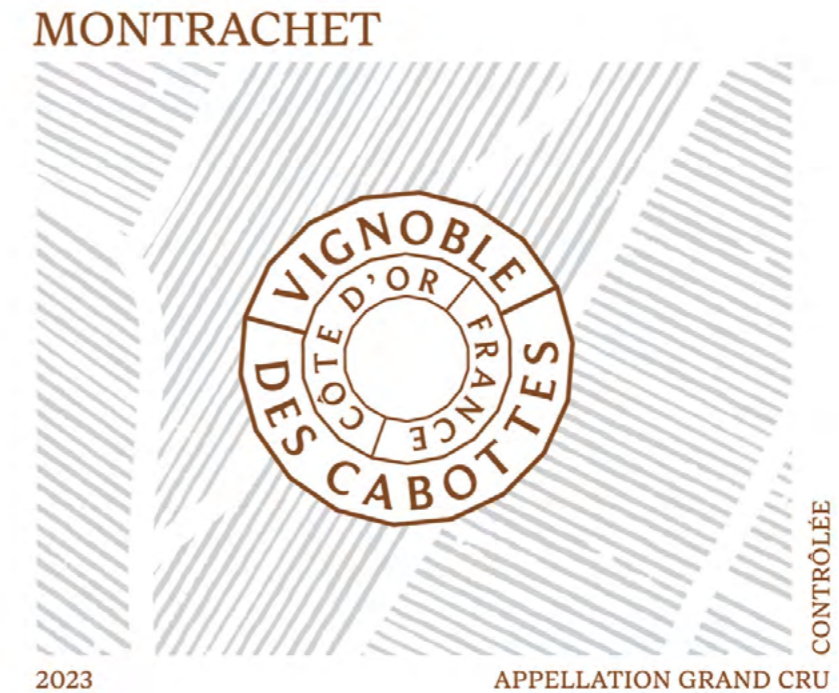
Montrachet Grand Cru

Over the centuries, Montrachet has earned the nicknames ‘White Vine of the Lord’ and ‘King of Kings’. Today, it is unanimously regarded as the greatest dry white wine of Burgundy.

- Altitude: 260 meters
- Soils: clay and marl
- Exposure: East / South-East
