

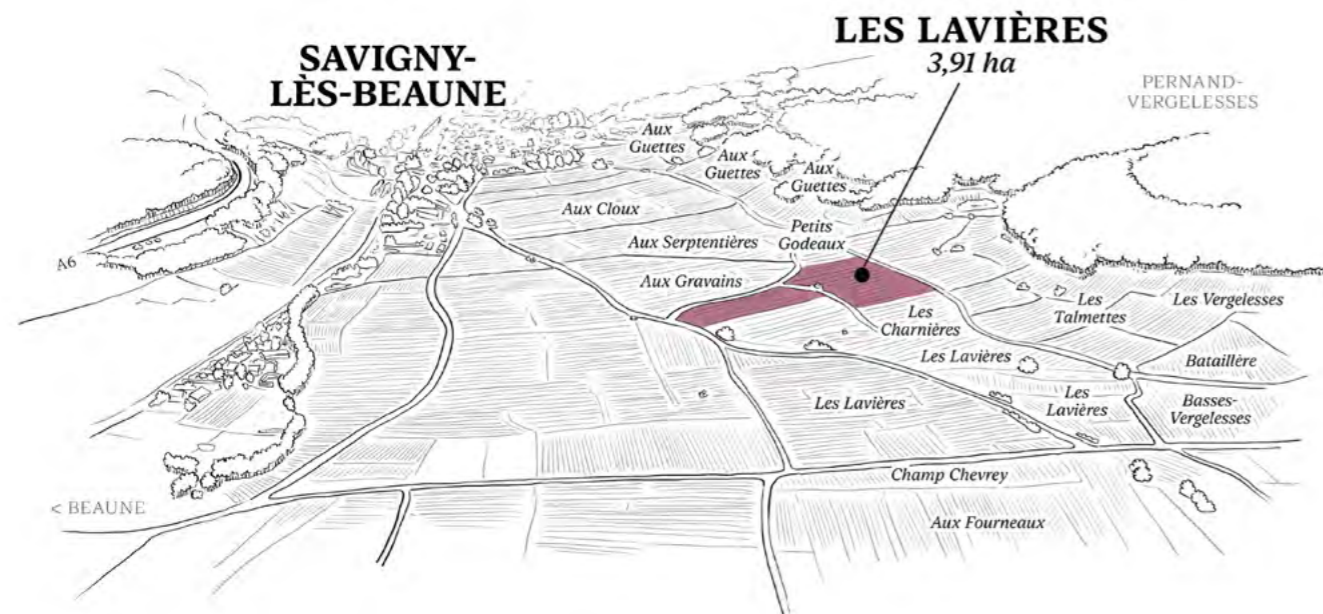
# Savigny-lès-Beaune Les Lavières

## Premier Cru

2023 Vintage

One of the most beautiful climats of the appellation, its name comes from the 'laves', thin, flat stones once quarried from the soil and used to cover traditional Burgundy roofs

- Acquisition date: 1909
- Surface: 3.94 hectares
- Altitude: 260 meters
- Soils: calcareous clay
- Exposure: South



*‘A very pretty pinot nose, fine and elegant, with notes of Burlat cherries and gentle spices. The palate is smooth and ripe, revealing aromas of perfectly ripe black fruits, and soft spices on the finish.’*

- Harvests: September 8 & 9, 2023
- Whole cluster: 30%
- New oak: 35%
- Ageing: 20 months
